Paid Wait List Deposit Terms (For a puppy from an upcoming litter): *

I understand that if I join the paid wait list for a puppy from a future litter, I need to pay \$450.00 Incl to go on the paid wait list and once I am confirmed a puppy after the litter is born I am to pay a second deposit of \$550.00 Incl & understand that my wait list deposit & second deposit will be deducted from the final puppy price and once paid all deposits are non-refundable.

I understand that my wait list deposit is non-refundable & acknowledge that running a wait list takes time due to the multiple steps & planning that goes on in the background*.

I understand that should a puppy not match my preferences from the litter that I am wait listed on, my deposit will be transferred to the next litter with available puppies

I understand that my deposit or spot on the wait list is not transferrable to another family member or friend & if paying in full for an older puppy, \$950.00 of that payment covers the wait list payment which is non-refundable.

Not applicable as I'm joining the non-paid wait list & understand that should I pay a deposit when a puppy becomes available that the same conditions listed above apply to any deposits paid

ONCE YOU ARE ON THE PAID WAIT LIST - For upcoming litters

PUPPY OFFER: A few days after the litter has arrived and mum and pups have settled into their groove, we will send you an email with a group photo to let you know what arrived (how many boys or girls & colours). You will have 48 hours to get back to us if you are wanting to go ahead with a puppy from that litter. If you are wanting to go ahead with a puppy, we will then contact you by phone.

PUPPY DEPOSIT: Only after we have spoken with you a puppy deposit payment of \$550 inclusive is payable within 24 hours to secure you a pup from that litter. This puppy deposit is <u>non-refunable</u> & will also be deducted from the final puppy price (along with your wait list deposit & once paid will also be non-refundable).

If any of the pups are 'Ready to go now' a deposit of \$950.00 (non-refundable) & if paid in full, \$950.00 of payment is considered as the deposit and is non-refundable.

*DEPOSITS: All deposits are non-refundable and a committment that you have made to us by acknowledging our terms above. We don't know of too many people who go to work for free & neither do we. Running a wait list and litter lists takes a lot of work & effort & we find it offensive when someone thinks our time is not as valuable as theirs. We would 'only' consider a part refund (less a \$200 administration fee) if it was extreme circumstances such as a terminal illness & a medical paperwork is provided as evidence of this (which we would keep confidential & not disclose any private information to any third party).

ALLOCATIONS & FINAL PAYMENTS: We do vet checks at week six & once we know everyone has gotten a gold star from our vet, we pick our breeding lines & then do puppy allocations. This is where we ring you to discuss with you which pup/s we think best matches your preferences & would be the best fit for your family & you get to tell us which one you think sounds like the best fit for you and your family. If you haven't paid in advance, final payments are due after allocations & vet checks at week six (6) or if puppy is older than eight weeks, full payment is required.

INTERSTATE PUPPIES: Puppies that are travelling by plane will be sent a trasnport invoice separately to their puppy invoice. The additional travel costs (airline approved crate \$85.00, airport drop off fee \$100.00, and the optional items we HIGHLY RECOMMEND is the vet dry bedding crate mat and adaptil collar & we can be included on the transport invoice. We like to get the transport invoice sorted & paid asap so we can secure the booking as soon as possible so we don't miss out on flights (they only have limited spots & should we get impacted by any flight restrictions should we have another situation silimiar to COVID but we would be sure to keep you updated on this).

PRICING: As of May 2024, our pricing is as reflected above & the application pricing is the most up to date pricing (should it differ to our website). All pricing is reviewed every six months to ensure we are keeping in line with other breeders, vet costs & other providers. Any new pricing will be applicable to puppy sales from that time. Any older pups that are sold at a discounted only qualify for two free months pet insurance.

PET INSURANCE: All puppies (that leave at 8 weeks of age) come with two Months FREE Pet Insurance from our wonderful friends at KNOSE Pet Insurance. Any changes with pet insurance policies will be applicable to pup sales at that time.
